Join us for an extensive overview of the Seine

Enjoy authentic Parisian ambiance on board
and a perfect mixture of history and nature

Embark on a cruise where heritage and history are as rich as they are exciting. Discover Château-Gaillard, which has been watching out from its rocky outcrop for over 800 years and towering over Les Andelys and one of the most beautiful meanders of the River Seine. Discover Honfleur, the cradle of Impressionism, this small port has kept the landmarks of its rich past, making it today one of the most visited towns in France. Visit Rouen, a real museum city, a memorable experience with its beautiful half-timbered houses, cobbled streets and Gothic churches.

DAY 1 : 11 NOV 2018 : PARIS

Passengers are welcome to board our ship at 5:00 p.m. After comfortably settling into your cabins, we'll introduce our crew at a welcome cocktail. We'll set out for a cruise through Paris by night (depending on the water level).

DAY 2 : 12 NOV 2018 : PARIS - LES ANDELYS - ROUEN

This morning will be spent cruising.

This afternoon, join us for the **excursion proposed**: walk to the Château Gaillard.

Come discover this ruined medieval castle and its gorgeous views overlooking the small city of Les Andelys and one of the loveliest bends in the Seine. Construction of the castle began in 1196 under Richard the Lionheart, who was both King of England and Duke of Normandy. The complex and advanced-design castle was expensive to build, yet the majority of the work was done in an unusually short time.

We'll return on board in Les Andelys and start sailing towards Rouen.

DAY 3 : 13 NOV 2018 : ROUEN - HONFLEUR

This morning will be spent cruising.

This afternoon, join us for the **excursion proposed**: guided walking tour of Honfleur.

We'll begin our tour at the Vieux Bassin, one of the most charming sites in the city. The narrow houses squeezed against each other are quite a unique sight. Next, we'll see Saint Catherine's Church, the largest wooden church in France. It was



listed as a historical monument in 1879 and has been the subject of scrupulous research by many archaeologists and historians. We'll then head for the original 17th-century Salt Halls (Greniers à Sel), now used for exhibitions, conferences and concerts. Our tour will finish with a visit to Saint Léonard Church. Destroyed during the Hundred Years War, it was rebuilt at the end of the 15th and beginning of the 16th centuries—only to be partially burned down again during the Wars of Religion.

We'll return on board in Honfleur.

DAY 4 : 14 NOV 2018 : HONFLEUR - ROUEN

This morning, join us for the **excursion proposed:** guided tour on foot of Rouen.

The historic center of Rouen and its famous cathedral are only a 5-minute walk from the ship. Stretched along the Seine, Rouen is Normandy's cultural, historical, and gastronomical capital. Destroyed during the Viking invasions in 841 and, partially, in 1944, by allied bombings, the exceptionally complex Notre-Dame Cathedral is renowned for the juxtaposition of all the Gothic periods. We'll walk past the Gros-Horloge (or Great Clock), one of the most emblematic monuments in the city, located right next to a Gothic belfry which has housed the communal bells and clock of the city since its construction at the end of the 14th century. Finally, we'll visit the Saint Joan of Arc Church on the Old Market Place, built both in honor of the Saint as well as the heroine celebrated by the French on the second Sunday in May.

We'll spend the afternoon cruising. An authentic "guinguette" will recreate the atmosphere "of Sundays on the banks of the Marne." We'll cruise through magnificent landscapes of steep chalk cliffs. Tonight is our gala dinner and evening.

DAY 5 : 15 NOV 2018 : PARIS

Enjoy one last buffet breakfast on board before disembarking at 9:00 a.m.

End of our services.

Includes: Your cruise with all meals from dinner the first evening to breakfast on the final day - drinks included in this price are water, wine, beer, fruit juices during the meal and coffee after both lunch and dinner for meals eaten on the ship - drinks from the bar, except for champagne or wines from our special list - double-occupancy cabin with shower in bathroom - assistance from our onboard multi-lingual host/hostess - welcome cocktail - gala dinner - onboard entertainment - excursions mentioned - travel assistance and repatriation insurance - all port fees.
